

MAXITOOOL DREDGING



CLIENT: South Walker Creek
PROJECT: Dredging project

Scope:

The South Walker Creek Coal Project is located approximately 40km west of Nebo in the northern section of the Bowen Basin and covers a strike length of 16km. The project was opened on a trial basis to produce and test the acceptance of South Walker Coal in the Pulverised Coal Injection (PCI) and thermal coal marketplace. Approximately 80 million tonnes of open cut Marketable Reserves are available.

Achievements:

In February 2012 the Rose Bud Cutter Suction Dredge removed 100,000 m³ of coal fines and clays, dredging a triangular 260 x 295 x 330 x 3m depth return water dam with a specific gravity of material at 1.3 – 1.5.
